



TCTSY-Facilitator's in Good Standing, practice in accordance with the Ethical Guidelines outlined below:

Commitment to the Client

- Commit to engaging in a therapeutic relationship as defined by the Principles & Practices of TCTSY.
- Provide TCTSY services without prejudice towards identities of sexual orientation, gender identity, culture, race, religious or spiritual affiliation, physical or cognitive ability or age.
- If a client's needs are not met by the practice of TCTSY, the facilitator will endeavor to provide appropriate referrals, being mindful to not induce feelings of shame and abandonment.
- Where appropriate, a therapeutic contract will be drawn up to ensure that a client is able to give informed consent when entering into TCTSY treatment.
- Commit to negotiating conditions on maintaining client confidentiality.
- Respect the integrity of a client's choice to engage in other trauma interventions.
- TCTSY-Fs will abstain from all sexual behavior with clients while facilitating TCTSY & for a minimum of 1 year after the conclusion of the TCTSY relationship.
- Sexual behavior is defined as, but not limited to, all forms of overt & covert seductive speech, gestures, behavior as well as sexualized physical contact.

Commitment to the Profession

• Comply with all TCTSY policies that pertain to certification status, including those that demonstrate competence to offer TCTSY facilitation, information sharings, mentorship of trainees and professional trainings.





- Commit to a process of continued professional development including but not limited to tutorials & seminars provided by CFTE to certified facilitators.
- Exclusively work with clients who are in a therapeutic treatment plan or who are accessing trauma spectrum support programs.
- As needed, commit to case consultations with a senior member of the TCTSY team.
- Commit to a practice of self-care and trauma stewardship that supports the safe delivery of TCTSY for our clients.
- Refrain from maligning colleagues including those whose work is not TCTSY based.
- Conduct the business of a TCTSY-F with honesty and integrity, and in accordance with all local and national laws.
- When possible, commit to supporting ongoing research into the efficacy of TCTSY.

Commitment to the Public

- Provide accurate information regarding education, professional affiliations, training, experience and certification status.
- Use accurate professional credentials & post-nominals.
- Advertise only accurate, truthful information in a nonmisleading manner.
